



#### JANUARY 2004 CATALOGUE LIST

First of all may we wish you and your families a healthy and happy 2004. As we said last month in our covering letter with our catalogue list we have not shut our premises in North Wales and are carrying on our business purely from our website which for those of you who are online has already had some additional items added through December.

As most of our stock is now packed into our garage and house we are going to limit ourselves to trading in smaller items mainly on the regimental and crested side. So to give you a flavour of what we can provide, here is a short list of some items that are new in at quite inexpensive prices:

- We have about a dozen Royal Marine sweatshirts and poloshirts mainly in green and navy. These items usually sell between £15 and £20, we have them on at £10 and £8.
- We have also now started carrying crested belts with buckles showing the badges of British Army Regiments.
- Another new item of which we only have a few and are at least half price, are ship's crests. Once again these are shown on the website.

If you are a collector and cannot go and see them we will send you a list of the names of them.

- Recently we purchased some cream British Army short sleeved shirts. The sizes are from 14 ½ to 16 ½ inches and they are extremely good quality. These are not civilian shirts and should last a long time.
- We are also carrying crested cufflinks, lighters, fridge magnets and also keyrings.
- Another interesting item we have just purchased are some French Origin Regiment US Civil War Hats. They can also be viewed on the website and for any of you who have bought Kepis off us we also have them now in Navy and Red as well as Navy and Silver and Navy and Gold.
- We also have now obtained a steady supply of the new SBS cap badge which is in cloth. If any of you collectors haven't managed to obtain one yet we can post them immediately.
- We also have a full Black Watch Dress Uniform with full waistcoat, kilt, sporran, dirk, etc. Photographs are on the website or once again we can send photographs to you.
- Finally, within the next two weeks we shall be purchasing a sword that was used at the Battle of Waterloo with, of course, verification. I have seen a photograph of it but have not yet obtained the sword and therefore cannot give you a description at the moment but if you wish to register an interest you can do.
